The Bucks County Conservation District (“District”) provides for the wise use, management, and development of the County’s natural resources through three main programs: Erosion and Sedimentation Control, Agricultural Conservation, and Watershed Management.

The District seeks a part-time (20-24 hour/week) summer intern for the period of mid-May through mid-August 2026. Compensation is \$15.00 /hour. Anticipated activities include, but are not limited to:

1. Water Quality Monitoring – Field maintenance of continuous monitoring equipment and collection/transport of discrete water samples.
2. Harmful Algal Bloom monitoring – Routine and targeted sampling for blooms of potentially toxic cyanobacteria.
3. Education and Outreach Support – Maintenance, set-up, and breakdown of interactive teaching models, assist with presentations or workshops. Compile/generate educational materials on variety of topics.
4. General Watershed Program support – residential site visits, tabling at public events, municipal support, lawn to meadow program assistance.
5. Accompany Agriculture Technicians and Environmental Protection Specialists as schedules permit.

The successful candidate will be a college student in an applicable field of study, have reliable transportation and valid driver’s license, be able to lift 40lbs and navigate variable terrain.
